Status update

- Great news – we have been reappointed! In June 2014, the Council of ICAO decided to reappoint Aviareto as the Registrar for a third term from 2016 to 2021.
- We are delighted to announce that in June we have reached a significant milestone - half a million registrations since the International Registry went live in 2006. In an average month we process ca. 7000 registrations.
- Contracting States Update: Kingdom of Bhutan has acceded to the Convention and Protocol (effective on November 1, 2014).

New website features

On Wednesday 23 July 2014, commencing at 0630GMT, we will be releasing the Q3 software update with several improvements and bug fixes, all driven by your feedback:

1. **CE conversion:** In line with section 4.3 of the Regulations, a TUE administrator will be able to convert, free of charge, any of their controlled entities to an independent transacting user entity
2. **Authorisation for multiple users:** When requesting authorisation, the users will be able to specify whether they are requesting authorisation for themselves individually, or for all users within their entity.
3. **No more entering tail numbers:** Nationality and Registration Marks field will be removed from the registration details screen on the International Registry website.
4. **Informational search:** The option to request a priority search certificate will be removed from the 'Search Registrations' view and added to the Informational Search popup window. Furthermore, the 'Object Type' field (airframe, helicopter, or engine) will be removed from the informational search results view and the informational search listing in order to avoid confusion.
5. **Payment Failure Notification:** If your credit card payment fails on the International Registry, you will receive a payment failure feedback message, based on the error response code received from the payment gateway.
6. **Change contract of Sale to Sale:** Throughout the International Registry website, the label "Contract of Sale" will be replaced with "Sale", and the label "Prospective Contract of Sale" will be replaced with "Prospective Sale". This change is in line with the Official Commentary.

There many more enhancements on the way, to be released quarterly over the next few years; next release will be in October.
